

Data Collection and Privacy

The GENDER-NET Plus consortium will collect, use and disclose personal data provided in the application form, and evaluation forms, for the purpose of processing the application. This will include scientific evaluation of the proposed projects, negotiating the funding decisions and analysing the applications data statistically. The consortium and funding agencies will publish generalised statistical information about the applications on their websites and by other means. More specific information such as names, positions, and affiliations will only be published about successful applicants. We will not link data that we collect with any other databases or registers.

In the Electronic Proposal Submission System (EPSS) of GENDER-NET Plus we ask you to provide personal data for the above mentioned purposes.

For the purpose of application evaluation and funding decisions, information may be accessed by external experts physically located in countries outside the European Economic Area. By submitting an application to the GENDER-NET Plus Joint Call, the applicants are agreeing that they consent to the processing of personal data which might involve access by users from outside of the European Economic Area.

Applicants must obtain the permission of any other person supporting their application, including but not limited to their non-academic partners if relevant, to provide personal information for processing and for the purposes outlined above.

The applicants have access to the EPSS of GENDER-NET Plus and are able to make amendments to their personal data until the application submission deadline 23 July, 2018.
