




## What is GENDER-NET Plus?

- A Consortium of 15 Research funding organizations from 12 countries
- FWF (Austria), FNRS (Belgium), CIHR (Canada), TA CR (Czech Republic), ETAg (Estonia), ANR, CNRS (France), HEA- IRC (Ireland), MOST (Israel), MOH-IT (Italy), RCN (Norway), MICINN, AEI, FBLC (Spain), SRC (Sweden)

= ERA-NET Cofund with EC top-up funding







# What is GENDER-NET Plus?

A scientific community
composed of almost 400
researchers participating in the
13 transnational projets co funded under GENDER-NET Plus
and integrating the sex and
gender dimension in research
content.







# Main objectives

- 1) Implement a joint co-funded call for proposals
- 2) Update and enlarge the mappings and analyses carried out in GENDER-NET on the promotion of gender equality in research and innovation
- 3) Carry out a joint assessment of gender differences and bias in access to research grants and define and develop appropriate conditions for promoting equal opportunities in research funding
- 4) Design transnational actions on the promotion of gender equality through institutional change and the integration of sex and gender analysis into research
- 5) Promote and disseminate key findings from the co-funded projects





### **GENDER-NET Plus joint call: topics**

#### Gender dimension in international research cooperation relating to UN SDGs

#### SDG 3 Good Health and Well-Being

- Gender-based violence
- Sex, gender and ageing
- Sex, gender and health

#### SDG 9 Infrastructure, Industrialization and Innovation

- Gender and new technologies
- Gender in entrepreneurship and the innovation system

#### SDG 13 Climate Action

Gender dimension in climate behaviour and decision making

#### **Call requirements**

- Research projects involving at least 3 countries
- Project duration (up to) 3 years (Covid-19: prolonged to 4 years)







### **GNP joint call: Process timeline**

**20 Dec 2017** Launch of call

Mid-July 2018

Deadline for submitting full proposals

(Step 2:33 proposals)

December 2018

Final Funding Decisions:

13 selected projects

**28 February 2023** 

End of funded projects

1 March 2018

Deadline for submitting preproposals

(Step 1:

**75 proposals)** 

End July to end of Sept 2018

Eligibility check and evaluation of full proposals 1 March 2019

Latest start of funded projects

# **Future steps**

Continue to network among funding agencies to foster support and capacity-building for research integrating the sex and gender dimension (including in other domains, like AI, robotics..)

Launch a network open to all researchers participating in the 13 transnational projects to continue interacting and exchanging on methods and best practices

Foster awareness-raising activities towards stakeholders on the importance of the societal impact of research integrating the sex and gender dimension
